## What is the dress code?

### What TO wear

- Disaster Relief Pin (**MUST BE WORN**)
- Appropriate pants (jeans or skirts that go up to the knee or lower)
- Sneakers/gym shoes
- The shirt that you wear should be SOLID COLOR (all white or all blue, etc.) OR FLAG THEMED. Please see above for examples. If you need to layer because of warmth during the school day, please **ONLY** wear a Rowe-Clark Sweater over your outfit.
- A combination of the following colors for your outfit:
  - Representation of the Puerto Rican Flag
    - Blue
    - Red
    - White
  - Representation of the Mexican Flag
    - Green
    - White
    - Red

### What NOT TO wear

- No Hats
- No cleavage
- Shoulders must be covered
- Tattoos must be covered
- No earrings (males)
- No jackets/hoodies
- No bandanas
- No boots/house shoes/flip flops/open-toe shoes
- No ripped jeans unless leggings are underneath
- No jeggings/joggers/sweat pants/pajama tops/bottoms/jean shorts
- No leggings (unless underneath jeans)
- No sagging of pants (wear a belt!)
- Nothing revealing
- Nothing gang related
- No cut outs
- No lace or sheer (see-thru) material
- No gym uniforms

Note: In order to ensure proper dress code is followed, if attire does not match the standards above, students **MUST bring and wear their FULL school uniform**. Students who fail to pass the proper dress code for this dress down day **will receive 4D** and potentially not be allowed in class. A suggestion would be to ask your advisor before wearing such attire.
